Purpose of the Role

Our community awareness volunteering opportunity is a new role for 2018. This role will be a mix between attending / delivering our workshops to community groups and organisations and attending community events to raise awareness of BulliesOut and the work we offer.

Role Description

Activities include:

- Initially assisting with the delivery of our workshops to community groups and organisations with a view to being able to deliver them in the future
- Initially assisting with community events the Charity is invited to attend with a view to taking responsibility for them at a later date
- Assisting with the promotion of our workshops to community groups and organisations in varying local authority areas
- Ensuring feedback is obtained for all community workshops delivered and recorded in line with the Charity's policies and procedures
- Latterly to be willing to coach and encourage new volunteers in the community worker role
- Complying with legal requirements, such as Data Protection and Confidentiality
- Liaising with your BulliesOut Coordinator to keep up-to-date with our activities and future direction
- Not bring the Charity's name into disrepute

- Excellent organisational and administrative skills
- Ability to maintain accurate and up to date records
- Honesty and reliability
- Ability to work on your own initiative or as part of a team

BulliesOut volunteers are people who, unpaid and of their own free will, contribute their time, energy and skills to support the purposes of the charity. BulliesOut volunteers may perform a variety of tasks and duties, under direction and guidance, using their skills, knowledge and time to help BulliesOut best achieve its objectives.

We respect and honour our volunteers by building trust and understanding. Such a partnership is not intended to be a legally binding contract or to have mutuality of obligation, but instead express a voluntary two-way commitment where everyone gains satisfaction from being part of our organisation.

Successful applicants will be required to:

- Undergo an enhanced DBS check (provided by BulliesOut)
- Provide two professional referees
- Sign a confidentiality agreement
